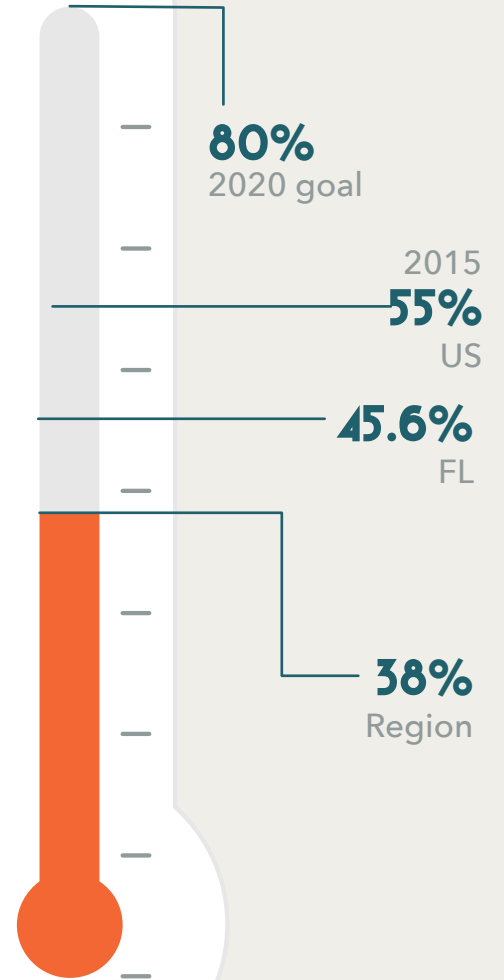


Higher education levels in nurses improves patient outcomes, infection and mortality rates
